TIME COMMITMENT

Rehearsals happen every day after school and last from 2 hours in Nov-Dec to 4+ hours as we get closer to opening night. They may do homework while not on stage, should be prepared by reviewing and rehearsing at home, and always need to communicate with the student and adult leadership teams should there be a need to miss a rehearsal (only before January 6, 2025). Please note this time commitment represents a smaller commitment than at other high schools.
